ON 28 MARCH, AN UNIDENTIFIED ARTILLERY ASSOCIATED ELEMENT WAS LOCATED IN AN AREA APPROXIMATELY 12 KILOMETERS SOUTHMEST OF QUANG TRI NEAR BASE AREA 181, IN THE VICINITY 01 16-39N 187-84E (YD 228 434).
