1. HIGHLIGHT

A. THE SECOND ATTACK ON THE DE SOTO PATROL, USS MADDOX

AND USS TURNER JOY, WAS LAUNCHED BY DRV NAVAL ENEMENTS ON 4-5 AUGUST. EXACT TIME AND POSITION ARE NOT AVAILA BLES FROM

COMINT, HOWEVER, HAIPNONG REPORTED AT 041546Z THE TWO

AMERICAN ASSAULT VESSELS WERE EXACTLY THIRTY-FIVE NAUTICAL

MILES EAST OF HON MATT (18-471.SQPTATIE). LATER T 041550Z

THE SWATOW T 142 REPORTED WE FIRED AT TWO AIRCRAFT ONE OF WHICH

WAS DOWNED. WE SACRIFICED TWO COMRADES BUT ALL ARE BRAVE AND

WE RECOGNIZE OUR OBLIGATIONS. OTHEJ THAN THE ABOVE NO

CLASSIFIED A. DRV NAVAL HEADQUARTERS HAIPNONG WAS ACTIVE WITH HANOI AND FOUR UNLOCATED OUTSTATIONS ON THE COMMAND NET AND WITH SOUTHERN FLEET HEADQUARTERS BEN THUY AND AN UNLOCATED NORTHERN FLEET SUBORDINATE ACTIVITY ON THE OPERATIONAL NET. REMAINING COMMAND ECHELON NETS NORMAL.

1. A MINIMUM OF EIGHT VESSELS WERE OBSERVED INCLUDING:


- 1. DRV COASTAL SHIPPING ACTIVITY NORMAL. POSSIBLE

REFLECTION TO THE DESOTO PATROL WAS NOTED IN TWO SEPARATE MESSAGES WHEN A POSSIBLE POSITION REPORT WAS PASSED TO HAIPHONG AND SUBSEQUENTLY WHEN HAIPHONG INFORMED HON GAY AND CAMPHA TO

REPORT IMMEDIATELY IF THE "SOUTHERN" VESSEL WAS SIGHTED SO THE NAVAL BUREAU COULD BE NOTIFIED.
