


Admiral SCHULZ wants to know what action has been taken re MADDOX. Replied that Col Lang was working, had sent msgs to the field, and that Col LANG expected enemy air reaction if nothing else to look for their burning PT boat. Adm SCHULZ wanted more info. I told him I would call back.




