Subject and Summary

- 1. Cryptographic Assistance to Thailand. USCIB 12./10 (COMSEC 2-18/1) forwarded to USCIB (and USCSB) the basic request received by the Army member from JUSMAG, Thailand for cryptographic assistance for the Thai Army. The broad nature of this request necessitated action to obtain further information. This information is reported in the enclosure with USCIB 12./15, which also contains the views of the Director, NSA on the problem, as submitted to USCSB for vote sheet action. All USCSB members approved the NSA views except the Army representative, who submitted comments with a request that USCIB views be sought. The Army views are quoted in USCIB 12./15, in which the Executive Secretary scheduled the problem for consideration by USCIB at this meeting. The Executive Secretary requested that comments by the Director, NSA and the Department of State member be made available for circulation prior to the meeting. The comments of the Director, NSA are contained in USCIB 12./16. Department of State comments will be forwarded at an early date.
- Personnel Security Standards. On 5 May 1955, the Executive Secretary prepared a resume of lessons to be learned from the Petersen Case (CIB # 000119), in which he recommended consideration of certain actions as a step toward improvement in the overall security program. Vote sheet replies were requested and, when received, were summarized in USCIB 13.1/7. In view of the replies received from the Defense member and the Director, NSA and after consultation with their representatives the Executive Secretary scheduled the problem for consideration at this meeting.
