Subject: Relocation of D/F Station (USM-6C) from U.S. Sector of Berlin [redacted]


Reference: USCIB 8.1/1 dated 14 May 1954.

1. Vote sheet replies to the reference indicate approval by all members, subject to the following:

(a) CIA Comment: "Approved with the understanding that the safeguards for risky situations set forth in Annexure B2 to Appendix B will be observed in connection with this operation."

(b) OSD Comment: "Following approval of this item by USCIB [redacted] it is suggested that relocation be handled directly by the appropriate military commanders in Berlin as directed by their parent service, if [redacted] has no objection. Referral to the Joint Chiefs of Staff is not believed necessary."

2. Pursuant to the recommendation contained in paragraph 3 of the enclosure with the reference, this office has asked [redacted] to request [redacted] approval of this proposal.
