MELIORANDUM FOR THE MEMBERS OF USCIB

SUBJECT: Relocation of RDF Unit from Bremerhaven

1. The Commander, U.S. Air Force Security Service, has determined by equipment tests and airborne calibration that the relocation of an RDF unit of the 41st RSM from Bremerhaven ________ would provide results far superior to the results obtainable at the present location, particularly in the area north of Berlin and in northern Poland. It is furthir suggested that this unit eventually could be enlarged to form a mobile flight of the 41st RSM with a maximum of 4 or 5 positions capable of VHF and HF R/T intercept, as well as RDF, in an area which is currently lacking both quality and quantity in VHF cover. Initially, however, relocation plans involve only RDF facilities.
