
~~CONFIDENTIAL~~MEMORANDUM FOR THE MEMBERS OF USCIB:

Subject: Conformance with Minimum Standards Governing  
Communications Security Systems.

References: (a) USCIB Directive Number 9 (Revised) dated  
4 February 1954.  
(b) USCIB 5.4/15 dated 8 July 1954.

1. The members of USCIB, other than the Department of Defense member and the Federal Bureau of Investigation member who operate no facilities for the electrical transmission of COMINT, have all reported that they have examined their COMSEC systems, procedures, practices and training programs for the transmission of COMINT by electrical means and have determined that they are operating in conformance with the minimum standards approved by USCIB for that purpose.

2. It is requested that the next semiannual inspection be performed in time to permit a report to be forwarded to this office by 1 June 1955.
