## MEMORANDUM FOR THE MEMBERS OF USCIB:

Subject:

Codewords.

- 1. Following USCIB agreement upon a general change of codewords coincident with the introduction of new categories of information, this office proceeded to coordinate the matter with U.K. authorities.
- 2. It was initially expected that arrangements could be made for the changeover as of 1 December 1954; however, a U.K. error in selection of codewords has precipitated a U.K. request that the effective date be delayed until 1 January 1955 to permit sufficient time for all concerned to prepare for the change.
- 3. This office has indicated to SUKLO, Washington, that the new date for introduction of codewords is acceptable to the U.S. and that U.S. agencies will proceed on this basis.
- 4. Information concerning the identity of codewords to be placed in effect has been hand-delivered to members of USCIBEC.
