USCIB: 29.5/13 Item C (Not on Agenda) for the 115th Meeting of USCIB, held on 20 May 1955.

Subject: [redacted]

GENERAL CANINE informed the members that he would like to present for information the content of a cable dealing with conversations between General Taylor and [redacted] on this subject. The cable read as follows:

"General Taylor had meeting with [redacted] evening of 16. Pursuant to strategy planned by General Taylor he did not leave papers with [redacted] but explained mission and obtained his agreement to deal with [redacted] Morning of 17 General Taylor and Lt. General Ferenbaugh, Deputy Commander, Eighth US Army (FWD) met with [redacted] with whom fol papers were left: Aide-Memoire slightly revised as memorandum for [redacted] signed by Gen Taylor, and 2 inclosure: a) minimum security standard, and b) suggested organization. Huggins, Melton and Weidman were introduced to [redacted] and latter was requested to inform us thru Ferenbaugh when his side was ready to negotiate. We then returned to Tokyo 17 with Taylor, and will stand by till further word. In addition to Ferenbaugh fol persons have been apprised of subject by General Taylor: J-2 FEC, SSR FEC, Ambassador Lacy, and General Lemnitzer, CG, AFFE/Eighth Army who will be Taylor's replacement as CINCFE."

The members noted the information presented.

The regular meeting adjourned at 1143, the members of USCIB and USCIBEC remaining for an Executive Session.
