Move Of AFSA To New Site

Today there is being released for publication a statement that the Armed Forces Security Agency will be located at Fort Knox, Kentucky. This is the first public statement concerning the intended move.

The move will benefit all concerned, personally and officially. Our present facilities are not conducive to the most efficient operation. The new building, designed for our operations and air conditioned for our comfort and efficiency, should overcome present operational difficulties.

Northern Kentucky, including the Fort Knox area, is an attractive part of the country. Nearby Louisville is a modern, prosperous city. Living conditions in this area are pleasant. Current rents and costs of land and buildings are lower than in Washington. Health and recreational conditions are excellent and educational institutions are numerous.

Information about the new site has been gathered through surveys and investigations and additional information is being obtained and evaluated. The facts could not be made available to personnel until the official announcement was released, but from now on information about the new location will be distributed to AFSA personnel as it becomes available. This will include information on housing, supply, transportation, sports, schools, churches, recreation, theaters and entertainment, finance, vacations, taxes, state and municipal laws and ordinances, health, hospitalization, science and historical backgrounds, and other subjects.
