1. DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF

Announced that Admiral Frost will be on TDY for ten days at Navy BuPers on a Navy selection board.

2. PRODUCTION

Commented on the unusually large number of people on tour throughout PROD. Chiefs of Offices and Staff Divisions are requested to clear through Training before sending anyone to PROD on tour.

3. GENERAL COUNSEL

Reported on recent legislation (PL 560, 83rd Congress), which has been signed by the President, providing for additional housing benefits for service men. Enlisted personnel who re-enlist and officers in indefinite tours benefit to the extent that VA loans are insured up to 95% and provide for maximum value of \$14,250. Complete details of this regulation will be published by the Secretary of Defense.

4. MOVEMENT GROUP

Stated that Barracks #1 at Fort Meade is now completed. Tests on the heating system and final clean-up will be made at which time the building will be turned over to NSA.

5. DIRECTOR

Outlined briefly his views on the article appearing in the Harvard Business Review, 'Resistance to Change" by Paul Lawrence. A reprint of this article was recently distributed by Training.
