Visit of SCAG Members. Subject:

Mr. J. C. McPherson and Dr. Shannon made a follow-up visit to the SCAG session of a week ago. They arrived about 0900 July 19 and stayed until the next afternoon. Most of the 19th was spent in Mr. Marston's office going over the evidence he has for his reconstructions. Some time was devoted to LCDR Hall's proof of the Gramer Conjecture on throws of wired wheels. This had been presented as a classic among the unsolved problems just the previous week. Interestingly enough, Shannon had the same approach, but was off the track slightly.

July 20th was spent at NavSecSta talking about the mathematical theory of wired wheels, with emphasis on the Roberts approach. Marston, Shepard, Wagner, Reimers and Levenson participated. Some discussion was devoted to BOOTSTRAPS.

Both McPherson and Shannon were highly interested.
