CDR LITTLE said that the regulations were in his opinion very thorough and very good. The laster of transmittal said that a brief would follow outlining and specifying certain "recent indiscretions". CDR LITTLE thought this probably referred to matters recently discussed by the Ad Hoc Committee. He said that his Committee would use the British material for what it was worth and discreetly, not violating any confidential discussions. He also said that the Committee would probably place the paper before the Standing Group and that he would like to discuss it withmakerer you and perhaps with other members of the Ad Hoc Committee before he presented it.
