Mr. Cooper: Have one more point that should be taken care of in the covering letter. There is one NATO nation that has been entirely left outside of all these discussions - Canada. I think that there should be something in the covering letter to say that we are informing the Canadians beforehand of the substance of this report and explaining to them in some way that it does not mean them.

Mr. Friedman: The cover letter to accompany the letter to the respective boards? I would like it if you would give the actual wording.

Mr. Millward: Submit a recommendation to the Board in the covering letter to accompany this report by way of explanation of any other issues and notes that are germane plus the assurance that this in no wise is considered to affect the Canadians. This should be passed to the cognizant Canadian authorities.
