MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Marshall Library

1. By letter dated 21 February 1984 (Tab 1), John Jacob advised me that he had found a document which appeared to have been declassified, but which lacked official declassification markings (Tab 2). Mr. Jacob telephonically advised me that he discovered the document at Tab 2 in the Friedman collection file styled B-4/F-39, a file which was one of those reviewed in our February 1984 visit to the Marshall Library.

2. Mike Levin, Q43, reviewed the document at Tab 2 and officially declassified it as indicated at Tab 3. Neither Mike Levin nor I recall having seen this document during our February 1984 visit to the Library and, accordingly, I have not inserted the document in the memorandum for the record prepared in respect to that visit.
