Russ Fisher, Senior Archivist, T5413, in the company of Mr. M. Levin, Chief, Q43, and [redacted] Office of the General Counsel, visited the George C. Marshall Research Foundation in Lexington, Virginia, from 7-10 February. The purpose of the visit was to review those documents in the William F. Friedman Collection which Messrs. Levin and Fisher had requested be removed from public access during their visit in April, 1983. Of the documents reviewed, approximately 10% were deemed to be sensitive enough to be classified. Some of these sensitive documents had been classified during the April visit. In the remainder, there were a few documents which had been similarly classified, but, due to changes in policy, and more detailed review, were declassified and returned to open shelving. The rest of the documents were deemed to contain nothing which requires special protection, and they, too, were again released to that portion of the Collection open to researchers and historians.
