I. AUTHORITY TO EXCUSE WAGE BOARD EMPLOYEES  
DURING WEATHER EMERGENCIES

Recent newspaper releases have stated that Public Law 395, 82d Congress, signed 10 June 1954, gives Wage Board employees the same rights as Classification Act employees in being excused with pay during weather emergencies. Information has been received that an Executive Order promulgating the President's regulations under Public Law 395 is being prepared. On receipt of the Executive Order, supervisors and employees will be informed as to the applicability of the law to Wage Board personnel. (PERS)

II. NAVY DEPENDENTS IDENTIFICATION CARDS

The NSA Badge Room in Building 7, NavSecSta, will continue to process applications for Navy Dependents Identification Cards through the week of 21-25 June between 0930 and 1600. (HqC)

III. NAVAL SECURITY STATION BULLETINS
