Dear Ralph:

Reference telephone discussion as to availability of centrally located housing at Fort Meade for your SAC enlisted women, I have had this matter carefully studied and I find that we can provide necessary facilities, with difficulty, as I will indicate below:

The only good location on the Post is in the vicinity of the present Fort Meade SAC Detachment where there is a group of two-story, mobilization-type buildings which would be adequate for about 100 enlisted women. There is no mess hall or day room so an additional building would have to be converted to a mess hall which would cost approximately \$50,000. It would be possible to utilize existing day room facilities in the present SAC area however.

The buildings which could be made available are, at present, being utilized by civilian employees who would have to be moved to other housing on the Post.

If, after further consideration, you desire that we proceed with this project, we will initiate action to obtain funds and get the work done. I expect that six months would be the minimum time from initiation of request.
