SUBJECT: Draft Reply to Questions Asked by Senator Fullbright
Relating to USS PUEBLO

1. The following is in confirmation of our telephone conversation on 1 March in regard to the reference, NSA Serial N 0328, subject as above, dated 29 February 1968.

a. Please change the last line of sub-paragraph 2.b. of the reference to read, the PUEBLO had previously broken radio silence by several transmissions on the 22nd in attempting to establish the ship to shore circuit. The earliest of these was at 220925Z.

b. The ship to shore circuit was established at about 230150Z whereupon the messages were transmitted.

2. In regard to Question 1 concerning the compilation of transmissions sent and received by USS PUEBLO, there is no objection to reproducing the missing pages listed, except that on page 34, the three lines beginning with the group "KONY" should be deleted inasmuch as they are technical code word material.
