6. Korean Situation.

PUEBLO incident, established a Senior Watch to represent and act for the Chief, B, on a 24-hour basis. This presence of high-level B personnel contributed to quick, efficient implementation of essential actions and immediate responses to queries from consumers - including the White House, U. S. Ambassador to the U.N., and other top governmental agencies. BØ4 and BØ5 also manned additional shifts during the period. BØ5 personnel prepared for the Director to a comprehensive narrative of the PUEBLO incident and subsequent developments during the period 23 January through 2 February. Bll commenced a round-the-clock work schedule and initiated a daily wrap-up.

Actions under way at the end of the month involved contingency planning provision of technical support, revision of arrangements with revised scheduling and routing of ACRP, new/restated requirements for telecommunications, and personnel augmentation.

The Chiefs of Bl and Bligh and Deputy Chief, Bluk (Korean linguist), accompanied Ambassador Goldberg at the U.N. in a variety of behind-the-scene roles.
