According to information from the METRO [i] the Foreign Office has decided not to rush with the question of the Baltic States since in their spinion a similar situation is coming to a head in Finland. They think that if the latter does coour it will cause great displeasure in SASHA [ii] whose line in this question the British intend to watch.
- 2. The fact that the SAUSAGE-DEALERS [EDIMASHIET][iii] are using large groups of aircraft 400-450 strong by day and that they are mainly bombing ports, i.e. the THAMES Estuary, PORTSMOUTH, SOUTHAMPTON, PORTIAND, CARBIFF and SWAMSEA, indicates that the SAUSAGE-DEALERS are endeavouring to paralyse the activity of England's main shipping centres [NORSKIE BAZY].
