To SEVERED[1]

According to information from "ENAR"[ii] who arrived from NORWAY on 5th October:

1. [25 groups unrecovered].
2. [1 group unrecovered] KIRKENES[KIRKENES][iii] [1 group unrecovered] machinery.
3. The road constructed from HAMMERFEST[GAMMUFEST][iv] to KIRKENES is the only line of communication; there are heavy movements of convoys[TRANSPORT] and troops.
4. TRONHEIM[TRONHOLM] - a submarine base and a shipyard for building submarines
[25 groups unrecovered].
6. SOLA[v] near STAVANGER - an aluminium works under construction[a].

[iii] KIRKENES: 69.44N: 30.03E, NORWAY.

[iv] HAMMERFEST: 70.35N: 23.50E, NORWAY.

[v] SOLA: Airport near STAVANGER.

[vi] ØRLANDET: Airport near TRONDHEIM.

[vii] AKASTO: ✓ Col. N.I. NIKITUSHEV, Soviet Military and Air Attaché in STOCKHOLM.
