To DIREKTOR.

On 1st April BARON[ii] reported to DIX[iii]:

[5 groups unrecovered] a large number of transports, with infantry, artillery, tank and armoured units proceeded from GERMANY via MELNIK[iv] to Č. TREBOVÁ[v], according to conversations with officers and soldiers,

[13 groups unrecovered]

convoy with units via: PRAGUE-TREBOVÁ[v]-OLMŮTZ[OL'MYU TS][vi]-PŘEROV[vii] [5 groups unrecovered] on the sectors: USTÍ[viii]/ORLICI[viii]-HANUSOVICE[ix] and OLMŮTZ [OL'METS]-KRNOV[x] towards POLAND.
