INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE FORMATION OF TWO NORWEGIAN GROUPS UNDER HANSEN AND HEDMANN (1942)

From: MOSCOW

To: STOCKHOLM

No: 264

16th April 1942

To AK/STO[i].

In reply to your No. 121[a].

Form the Norwegians into two separate groups[b].

Give the group [which is under][c] HANSEN[~~HANSEN~~] "SVANTE"[ii] a[d] MUSIC[MUZYKA][iii] and a[d] signals plan [PROGRAMMA]. The group's MUSICIAN[MUZYKANT][iv] will be FRANZEN[~~FRANSEN~~] "FRED"[v].

Link the second group [which is under][c] HEDMANN "FELIX[FELIKS]"[vi] to "SVANTE's" MUSIC through a post-box number[POCHTOVYJ YaShchIK] or an agreed address[e]. Teach "FELIX" the TIMUD[vii] also.

- [i] AKLSTO: Col. N.I. NIKITUSHEV, Soviet Military and Air Attache in STOCKHOLM.
  - [ii] HANSEN "SVANTE": Robert HANSEN NYGÅRD, a Norwegian RIS agent sentenced in STÅLEN in July 1942 for unlawful possession of a W/T set.  
  
HANSEN's covername "SVANTE" also occurs in STOCKHOLM's No. 737 of 19th April 1942 (3/NBF/T1808) and No. 872 of 8th May 1942 (3/NBF/T1783) and in MOSCOW's No. 710 of 30th September 1942 (3/NBF/T1608).
  - [iii] MUSIC: Coverword for a W/T set.
  - [iv] MUSICIAN: Coverword for a W/T operator.
  - [v] FRANTZEN "FRED": Frank FRANTZEN, a Norwegian RIS agent arrested in STÅLEN in early May 1942.  
  
FRANTZEN's covername "FRED" also occurs in STOCKHOLM's No. 872 of 8th May 1942 (3/NBF/T1788).
  - [vi] HEDMANN "FELIX": Frank HEDMANN occurs in STOCKHOLM's No. 656 of 8th April 1942 (3/NBF/T1800) Apart from this, he is not known.  
  
HEDMANN's covername "FELIX" also occurs in STOCKHOLM's No. 737 of 19th April 1942 (3/NBF/T1808), No. 872 of 8th May 1942 (3/NBF/T1788) and No. 873 of 8th May 1942 (3/NBF/T1688) and in MOSCOW's No. 343 of 11th May 1942 (not published) and No. 710 of 30th September 1942 (3/NBF/T1608).
  - [vii] TILMUD: Coverword for cipher or cipher system
