 [iii] ANDERSON: ✕ Probably Simon Odd SLIX-BERG, Norwegian RIS courier between SWEDEN and NORWAY. He arrived in the U.F. on 26th October 1942.
 [iv] FELIKS: ✕ i.e. "FELIX"; Frank HEDMANN. See STOCKHOLM's No. 655 of 5th April 1942 (3/NBF/T1889). The coverword FELIKS also occurs in STOCKHOLM's Nos. 737 of 19th April 1942 (3/NBF/T1988) and Nos. 872 and 873 of 8th May 1942 (3/NBF/T1788 and 1688) and MOSCOW's No. 718 of 30th September 1942 (3/NBF/T1681).
