AKASTO [iii]

Comments: [i] NORTHERN : MOSCOW addressee and signatory, so far occurring only in messages sent in Scandinavian lanes. Probably Northern Department.

[ii] BARD : Unidentified, probably a cover-name. BARD is a Swedish male Christian name. Other references are in MOSCOW No. 27 of 14.1.42 (3/NBF/T1602) and STOCKHOLM's No. of 17.2.42 (3/NBF/T1603). There is a single occurrence of the name BART which may be a variation of BARD (STOCKHOLM's No. 224 of 5.2.42 - 3/NBF/T1547).

[iii] AKASTO : Probably Col. N. I. NIKITUSHEV, Soviet Military attache in STOCKHOLM.
