To VIKTOR[i].

"LAN"[ii] has reported that Otto Marenius LARSEN[iii] born in [1 group unidentified][a], Ragnvald MIKKELSEN[Ragnval'd MIKKEL'SEN][iv] born in [C% 1920] and Emil Nikolaj ISAKSEN[v] born in 18% have arrived in SWEDEN: they[b] [B% said that][4 groups unrecovered] submarines [C% are preparing to carry out in future our] task [1 group unrecovered]. They had a transmitter but were unable to establish contact with the USSR. They have a good knowledge of the question and [B% head][c] the group which has been sent to NORWAY from the USSR. Those who have arrived wish to meet [representatives][d] of the Soviet Legation [MISSIYA]. I request your instructions.

We shall not [C% direct][1 group unrecovered] at "VOLKOV"[vi].

- [ii] LAN: X Unidentified covername. First occurrence. Possibly an error for "LAND" which occurs in STOCKHOLM's No. 3341 of 12th December 1943 (unpublished) and No. 3369 of 17th December 1943 (3/NHF/T1647).
- [iii] Otto Marenius LARSEN: According to a report of November 1946, three Russian agents resident in the KIBERG area, Einar ISAKSEN, Ragnvald MIKKELSEN and Otto Marenius LARSEN, were engaged in organising a courier service on behalf of the RIS between NORWAY and SWEDEN.
- [iv] Ragnvald MIKKELSEN: See Comment [iii] above.
- [v] Emil' Nikolaev ISAKSEN: See Comment [iii] above. Presumably Einar ISAKSEN, in spite of the discrepancy in Christian names.
- [vi] VOLKOV: Unidentified covername. First occurrence.
- [vii] VALERIAN: Vasilij Fedorovich RAZIN, 1st Secretary at the Soviet Legation in STOCKHOLM.
