ABRAM[1] has known [11] since June 1943 as a . They often met on official business connects with the Press Bureau but did not [B: discuss] questions of interest to us. The last talk took place on the initiative of [1 group unrecovered] in connection with newspaper items. has never been to JAPAN. He has been to the U.S.A., BRITAIN and SWITZERLAND. He has very considerable connections here.

According to TERENTIJ[iv] [9 groups unrecovered], but he refuses to give his[b] surname.
