As your telegram arrived on [1 group unrecovered] it was not possible to get in touch with the necessary agents [AGENTURA] and meet the [1 group unrecovered] persons. It will thus not be possible to complete your task until the beginning of next week.

Meanwhile preliminary [4 groups unrecovered] the "STUMM" combine [KONTAERU][ii] owns iron works in NEUNKIRCHEN and DILLINGEN (the latter is on the river LAAN [LAAN][iii]). The managing director [RUKOVODITEL'] of the "STUMM" combine is

Wilhelm von STUMM[v], who was born in 1869, and has worked in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs since 1917. As "UCN 37"[iv] at one time informed "IRUC"[vi], the chairman of the STUMM combine is Director STUMM (Christian name unknown). [B% We are continuing][to receive][b] information which is of interest to us from "KHOCHEV"[vii].

[ii] STUMM Combine: ✓ The "NEUNKIRCHER EISENWERK A.G.", formerly "GEBRÜDER STUMM", NEUNKIRCHEN/SAAR. For another reference to the STUMM firm see STOCKHOLM's No. 3066 of 19th November 1943 (3/NBF/T1666).

[iii] LAHN: There appears to be an error here, since the DILLINGEN noted for heavy industry is in the SAAR, not the LAHN, valley.

[iv] UCN 37: ✗ Unidentified.

[v] Wilhelm von STUMM: ✓ Wilhelm August von STUMM: appears to have worked in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs up to about 1917.

[vi] IRUC: ✗ i.e. "FRIEND"  
Also occurs in STOCKHOLM's Nos. 2978 of 12th November 1943 (3/T32/T1664), 3152 of 26th November 1943 (3/NBF/T1689), and 3299 of 9th December 1943 (3/NBF/T1690).

[vii] KHOCHEV: ✗

[viii] VALERIAN: ✓ Vasilij Fedorovich RAZIN, 1st Secretary at the Soviet Legation in STOCKHOLM.
