From a description of the 75-millimetre aircraft cannon [AVIATsION-NAYa PUSHKA] M-4 received from OPPEN [11], it is evident that it is a modification of the 75-millimetre field gun M-3. In front the barrel is fitted with four [8 groups unrecovered] upon ejection of the shell case and opening by it when the shell is rammed fully home into the chamber. The total weight is 560 kilograms, the length
