To the Director.

BRÈME [BREM][1] reports:

1. From <sup>15</sup>1st [a] May to <sup>23rd June</sup> [1 group unrecovered] from the ports of NEW YORK there were despatched 108 [vessels][b] of which 12 were for England, 22 for Africa and the remainder for unknown destinations. [2 groups unrecovered].
