[1] Name AJ: Possibly the Director of Naval Intelligence (VORONTSOV?). (It ought to be noted that when code-groups for names are tentatively identified with individuals whose names elsewhere occur spelled out, the presumption is that the code-book value is a cover name, the form of which may never be known.)
[ii] Name BT: Possibly the Espionage Resident, WASHINGTON.
[iii] Name CB: Possibly BOGDENKO, Director of Operations from March, 1943.

[iv] Name CE: Possibly EGORICHEV, Naval Attache, WASHINGTON.
