A BRITISH OFFICER'S CONVERSATION WITH LEVANGER (1943)

From: STOCKHOLM

To: MOSCOW

To the DIRECTOR.

[Part I] . During a conversation with LEVANGER [i] Major FLEET [FLIT] [ii] gave him the following information about the Me 109F and Me 109G.

Comments: [i] LEVANGER : Unidentified. This could be a Norwegian surname or a cover-name. For another occurrence see STOCKHOLM's No. 1536 of 21st July, 1942 (3/NBF/T:67).

[ii] FLEET : D. H. FLEET was British Assistant Air Attaché in STOCKHOLM. The rank "Major" corresponds to Squadron-Leader in the Royal Air Force.

[iii] ORN : Probably Lt. Col. Serafim PINYUGIN, Soviet Assistant Military and Air Attaché in STOCKHOLM.
