- [Cont'd]: [iii] ASIEV: Major Pavel Nikolaevich ASEEV, in the United States from November 1941 to September 1944, was employed in Washington first as secretary to the Soviet Military Attaché and later as Assistant Military Attaché.
- [iv] ROUEN: Probably Col. Il'ya Mikhaïlovich SARAEV, Assistant Soviet Military Attaché in Washington.
