According to U.S. Naval Intelligence [0% there has been a report] about the economic importance to FINLAND of the network of internal waterways of the SAIMI. The SAIMI canal has already been repaired. It is thought that construction work will soon begin in VARKAUS for the purpose of making it possible for the port to accept vessels of 2,500 tons displacement.
