- Footnotes: [i] KROTOV: Ivan Ivanovich KROTOV, Soviet Commercial Counsellor in OTTAWA.
- [ii] HUDENKO: Lt. General Leonid Georgievich HUDENKO, Chairman S.G.P.C., WASHINGTON.
- [iii] YAKIMOV: Rear Admiral Aleksandr Andreevich YAKIMOV, a Deputy Chairman, S.G.P.C., WASHINGTON.
- [iv] RAZIN: Leonid Alekseevich RAZIN, Head of the S.G.P.C. in PORTLAND.
- [v] Aleksandr ...ich NAZAROV: Probably Aleksandr E. NAZAROV, who arrived VANCOUVER (via LOS ANGELES) on 10th July 1944: Traffic Officer, office of the Commercial Counsellor, until June 1945, when he replaced Yurij M. BARKOV (see Footnote [vi]) as Cargo Inspector.
- [vi]evich BARKOV: Probably Yurij M. BARKOV, Cargo Inspector, office of Commercial Counsellor, VANCOUVER, from early 1944 to June 1945, when he was replaced by Aleksandr E. NAZAROV (see Footnote [v]).
- [vii] KRUTIKOV: Aleksej Dmitrievich KRUTIKOV, Deputy People's Commissar for Foreign Trade.
