CRUCIAN [KARAS'] [1] has been elected Chairman of the Trade Union of Yugoslav Seamen [and] [a] in this connection he will go in the near future to SIDON [11], where he will take up his duties. The group which was sent to Yugoslavia and with which, with his mediation, we agreed on a password, arrived at its destination long ago. CRUCIAN [1] received from it a report through RABIN's wife that his wife, whose maiden name is Vesela SHEVCHICH [111] works on TITO's staff.
