To VICTOR.

1. In view of the fact that after MAKSIM's<sup>[i]</sup> departure we shall be deprived of liaison with the STORE [MAGAZIN]<sup>[ii]</sup> and also of the [O; COMBINE's] [O; KOMBINGAT<sup>[AT]</sup>]<sup>[iii]</sup> system of liaison with us for processing [OFORMLENIE] members of the TEN [DESYATKA] in CARTHAGE [KARFAGEN]<sup>[iv]</sup> and BABYLON [VAVILON]<sup>[v]</sup> in accordance with your instructions please sanction personal liaison between ANTON and the master [KHOZYAIN]<sup>[vi]</sup> of the STORE [MAGAZIN]<sup>[ii]</sup>.

2. MAKSIM<sup>[i]</sup> proposes to utilise TEACHER [UCHITEL'NITSA]<sup>[a]</sup> for technical liaison with MAYOR [MAYOR]. If you object [3 groups unrecovered] [O; NELLI [NELLI]] from DECREE [DEKRET]<sup>[vii]</sup> to meet MAYOR [MAYOR] meetings with him not [1 group unrecovered] through SERGEJ's wife<sup>[viii]</sup> or LINA<sup>[ix]</sup>. [b] Telegraph your decision.
