Comments: [i] VALENTIN : Unidentified ISTANBUL addressee.

[ii] SAVINOV : May refer to Boris Aleksievich SAVINOV, one of a group of Russians who entered TURKEY from BULGARIA by rail on 8th September 1944 and reached ISTANBUL the following day. Cf. ISTANBUL's No. 141 of 11th September 1944 (3/NEP/T1174) which reports the arrival of "DON's" party from SOFIA. SAVINOV remained in ISTANBUL as Vice-Consul and Press Attaché from 1944 to 1947.
