INSTRUCTIONS FROM "PETROV" REGARDING DISCIPLINE
AMONG CREWS OF SHIPS OF THE PEOPLE'S COMMISSARIAT
OF THE FISH INDUSTRY.

SAN FRANCISCO, copy to NEW YORK, OTTAWA.

Recently there has been noticed the fact that there has been a considerable decline in discipline among crews of ships of the People's Commissariat of the Fish Industry [NARKOMRYBPROM], in particular [6 groups unrecovered] repairs in the ports of SEATTLE and PORTLAND. Sailors from these ships living in hotels are not [B% controlled] by the representatives of the People's Commissariat of the Fish Industry, indulge in drunkenness [and] [a] get into the hands of the police. In consequence of demoralisation there have occurred two cases of treason. Take energetic steps to improve the work of the [B% representatives] of the People's Commissariat of the Fish Industry and to put a stop to demoralisation among the sailors. In accordance with an understanding with the ~~political ambassador representative~~ [POLPRED] organise appropriate explanatory work among the crews of vessels and take all necessary agent-operational steps to prevent the occurrence of cases of treason.
