MEETING BETWEEN TALLINER AND KLARA: POLITICAL  
SITUATION IN FINLAND DISCUSSED  
(1944)

[R% The other day]TALLINER[1] arrived from FINLAND[.][a] On 24th February 1944 KLARA[11] had a meeting with him. He said that the most [C% serious] problem currently before the Finnish Government is what action to take as regards the Germans. The Government realises that the Germans need [D% to send] forces [4 groups unrecovered] said that "FINLAND is waging a separate war and can, therefore, conclude a separate peace". [D% TANNER][111], who in the past was pro-German, now insists on the Germans leaving FINLAND. Indeed [R% the Germans] guarantee [1 group unrecovered], the FINNISH Government is united in
