On 25 October 1944 "JAN" (Yan) related from what he was told by [8% his friend](a) [C: REINDLER (REJNDLER)], who has arrived from [8% Finland], that [D% in] HELSINKI there is living as before a German, \_\_\_\_\_ Address -
