On 27th/28th November the local Soviet citizens Georgij YuShchENKO, Viktor ShISHOV and VERTKOV were arrested as well as several emigrés. Some of [1 group unrecovered] are connected with the NEAR NEIGHBOURS [BLIZhNIE SOSEDI][ii]. According to [1 group unrecovered] information, [3 groups unrecovered] still some people who are connected with the NEAR NEIGHBOURS. I consider it desirable to withdraw some of the NEAR NEIGHBOURS' officials, particularly STETsYuK[iii] and ChE...KOV[iv]. I request your instructions.
