To VALENTIN. [i]

While in ANKARA, ARTEM [ii] on behalf of a member of the "Free Germany" [iii] Committee WOLF [iii] established contact with [iv], henceforth "FIGARO". Up to the time of his departure in August this year "FIGARO" will be in ISTANBUL. His address and details of the case are known to [v: ARKADIJ] [iv]. According to the understanding with ARTEM, "FIGARO" [vi: on behalf of] the representative of the "Free Germany" [v: Committee], is to send an intermediary to LEUSCHNER [LEUSCHNER] [v] to get information about the opposition movement in Germany. Further work with "FIGARO" is entrusted to you. As a preliminary see [v: ARKADIJ], ascertain the details of the case, acquaint yourself with our directives. Direct your attention to "FIGARO's" close connection with "Taln" [vi: study "Taln" through "FIGARO", obtain from him very detailed biographical data on Taln. The password "Greetings from MAI[MAES]" has been arranged with "FIGARO", ~~which~~ be known ~~to~~ [v: groups unrecovered] KIP[DEE] [vii]. Telegraph results of the meeting.
