Comments: (i) This internal serial number is used for the second of two messages transmitted under external serial number 1691 of 1 Dec 1944; it was signed by WIZ, and dealt with an entirely different subject (see S/HR/T157, Item 2). The message of which the present text gives the last part probably contains material derived from HED (Theodore Alvin Hill). Previous re-use of an internal serial number is not without precedent on this line.
