Further to our telegram No. 163[a] of 12th July. In conversation with the convoy officer, REDIN, [ii] it was ascertained that SMIRWOV[iii] was to have left [I% the certificates][D% SVIDETEL'STVA] in PORTLAND, but on his return to SEATTLE he was found to have them with him. Before leaving FORTLAND, SMIRNOV called in at the Cipher Office [SShO] of the Purchasing Commission, but it is not known what he took from there, as no check is made on documents contained in sealed packages.
