To PETEROV[1].

Reference your telegram of 30 April[a].

1. ~~ZARÉ~~ [ii] is taking individual lessons at the FACTORY [FABRIKA][iii] three times a week; ~~ZARÉ~~ [iv] put her in the same room with the wife

ANTON

[44 groups unrecoverable]

in all there are four courses.

3. ~~ZARÉ~~ receives 217 and she does not complain about her material circumstances.

4. Until recently ZARÉ [1 group unrecovered] has not complained of particularly noticeable nervous trouble. She only reported to ANTON today that she had started a cough. ANTON has sent her to a lung specialist. We will report the results.

5. Today in reply to ANTON's enquiry ZARÉ announced for the first time that she had been preparing to go to CALIFORNIA to an Indian settlement [4 groups unrecoverable] way of life [1 group unrecovered] of the inhabitants.
