SOSIN's FAILURE IN HIS DUTY.

Reference No. 49[i]. SOSIN[ii] has continued to meet his sister and the intelligence worker [RABOTNIK RAZVEDKI] ZhURENKO[iii]. The latter was at SOSIN's on board ship with his family. ZhURENKO has also been frequently at SOSIN's sister's. SOSIN has often returned on board ship between 4 a.m. and 7 a.m. SOSIN has not reported his meetings [C. with] ZhURENKO, although as a probationer [STAZHER] it is his duty to do so. "PETR"[iv] considers it inadvisable to permit SOSIN to sail in foreign waters in future.
