Local newspapers report the arrival of KERENSKIJ [i] in MELBOURNE on 8th November 1945. The latter told a press representative that his visit to AUSTRALIA does not pursue any political aim but [3 groups unrecovered] [O% will see off] his wife [ii] (a former Australian, maiden name NELL TRITTON) to visit her family in BRISBANE. Note: [O% Do you consider it expedient] to charge "FORMER [BYVSHIJ]" to go out to BRISBANE and find out there details [B% about the visit] [16 groups unrecovered]

Comments: [i] Aleksandr Fedorovich KERENSKIJ, Prime Minister of Provisional Government of RUSSIA in 1917. Refugee after October Revolution. Leader of Russian Socialist-Revolutionary Party. [Local records].

[ii] KERENSKIJ's wife is of Australian origin. [Local records].
