In October 1945 an International Youth Congress is taking place in the "ISLAND [OSTROV]" [ii]. Our delegation consists of six parts - Central, Ukrainian, Belorussian and Baltic Countries [iii] - in all sixty persons. Included in the delegation [1 group missing] four of our colleagues - senior member of the group MON [Q, IN] [iv]

[21 groups unrecoverable]

On 15th September our representatives, numbering eight persons, are leaving for the "ISLAND" for work on the preparatory Committee [v] of the Congress. It is with this group that MONIN is leaving. Our colleagues have been briefed on [1 group missing] looking after the delegation and will, [Q] under the auspices of the Central part, work ~~separately~~ under the direction of "PLATO [PLATON]" [v]. The Chairman of the whole delegation, MIKHAILOV, [vi] the First Secretary of the Central Committee of the All-Union Communist League of Youth [TsK ~~WSSR~~], is also leaving with the first group. According to MIKHAILOV's information the delegations of a number of countries - ITALY, U.S.A., SPAIN and others, include ~~1 group~~ members of "FRATERNALS [BRATSKIE]" [vii]

Communist Parties.
